



## Sapper N. A. Rose (Higham), R.E

KILLED AT THE DARDANELLES.

Mr. and Mrs. George Rose, of "Glendeeker," Higham, have received intimation of the death of their second son, Sapper Norman Allan Rose, of the Signal Service, R.E. He left England for the Dardanelles on August 2nd last, and was killed in action on Sept. 12th, at the age of 18.

Sapper Rose started his career as a learner at the Gravesend Post Office. After being there for nine months he was transferred to Erith, and six months later was offered an appointment at the Gravesend Post Office, but he patriotically put his country before his own advancement, and joined the R.E. as telegraphist. Sapper Rose, by his bright, kindly, and unselfish disposition, endeared himself to all with whom he came into contact, and he will be sadly missed by his host of friends in Higham, where he had lived nearly all his short life.
